



## 4698 Master of Health Science (Health Services Management)

### Trimester 3 2024 New Student Advising Guide

This Advising Guide has been specifically created for students enrolled in a Master of Health Science with a Specialisation in Health Services Management via a 2 year pathway at Western Sydney University, Sydney City Campus.

This guide provides students with details of the subjects they will need to study to complete their degree. It is divided into 3 sections;

1. **Program structure:** subjects divided into categories (e.g. Core, Key Program and Elective).
2. **Subjects per Trimester 2024:** subjects available each Trimester NB you may also see Trimesters referred to as Trimesters, Terms or semesters in WSU documents).

#### Study load options

Fulltime study: Students should select 3 subjects per Trimester  
(International students are required to study a full-time load)

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Part-time study: Students should select 1-2 subjects per Trimester

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#### Subject prerequisites and assumed knowledge

#### Advanced Standing

Students who have received Advanced Standing for previous study should make sure they take into account which subjects they have been granted credit for, before selecting their subjects to study at Sydney City Campus.
