Trimester 2 2026 New Student Advising Guide

This Advising Guide has been specifically created for students enrolled in a Master of Health Science with a Specialisation in Health Services Management via a 2 year pathway at Western Sydney University, Sydney City Campus.

This guide provides students with details of the subjects they will need to study to complete their degree. It is divided into 3 sections;

1. **Program structure:** subjects divided into categories (e.g. Core, Key Program and Elective).
2. **Subjects per Trimester 2026:** subjects available each Trimester NB you may also see Trimesters referred to as Trimesters, Terms or semesters in WSU documents).
3. **Recommended sequences:** the recommended order of subjects a student should follow to complete their degree. Sequences have been provided to assist students with planning their enrolment. For more detailed information, students can book in with their Program Convenor Elizabeth Atteya or a Student Advisor (see information below).

Study load options

Fulltime study:	Students should select 3 subjects per Trimester (International students are required to study a full-time load)
Part-time study:	Students should select 1-2 subjects per Trimester

Advanced Standing
